AKRITAS signed the "Antwerp Declaration" for a European Industrial Deal

The Declaration, an outcome of the European Industry Summit held in Antwerp, Belgium on February 20, 2024, was signed by more than 630 companies from 20 different industrial sectors. This Declaration highlights the commitment of industry to the transformation of Europe and underlines the urgent need to strengthen its competitiveness, resilience and sustainability, through the collective effort of industry, governments and citizens. In this context, it calls on the governments of the member states, the European Commission and the Parliament to commit to the following 10 principles:

- 1. Put the Industrial Deal at the core of the new European Strategic Agenda 2024-2029
- 2. Include a strong public funding chapter with a Clean Tech Deployment Fund
- 3. Make Europe a globally competitive provider of energy
- 4. Focus on the infrastructure Europe needs
- 5. Increase the EU's raw materials security
- 6. Boosting demand for net-zero, low-carbon and circular products
- 7. Leverage, enforce, revive and improve the Single Market
- 8. Make the innovation framework smarter
- 9. A new spirit of law-making
- 10. Ensure that the structure allows to achieve results
